Facilities and Operating Standards

(a) Structure; construction. Housing facilities for dogs and cats must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.

The cattle panel on the east Golden Retriever pen has 6"x6" top openings that allows the head to protrude outward. Repair by using a wire mesh that prevents body parts from protruding out or prevents the entry of small mammals. Repair this east pen and/or others with the same problem.

(e) Storage. Supplies of food and bedding must be stored in a manner that protects the supplies from spoilage, contamination, and vermin infestation. The supplies must be stored off the floor and away from the walls, to allow cleaning underneath and around the supplies.

There is need to store feed in opened sacks in a sealed container that will prevent or discourage rats and mice from feeding from the unprotected contents. Found open sack of feed in trailer entry way. There was approximately 1000# of dog feed stored in new garage directly on the floor. Feed stored in this manner needs to be up on pallets that allow for ventilation and ease of cleaning.
