**HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.**

Housing facilities and areas used for storing animal food and bedding must be free of any accumulation of trash, waste material, junk, weeds, and other discarded materials. Housekeeping needs to be improved in the outdoor dog housing area behind building. The large garbage pile needs to be remove from this area. The floor of the outdoor shed needs cleaning to remove loose shavings and debris. Food needs to be remove from empty dog enclosures to discourage pests.

**INDOOR HOUSING FACILITIES.**

The floors and walls of indoor housing facilities, and any other surface in contact with dogs, must be impervious to moisture. (Note: An impervious surface does not permit the absorption of fluids and can be thoroughly and repeatedly cleaned and disinfected). The Styrofoam insulation on walls of indoor building on the first and second floors must be covered with a material or surface which is impervious to moisture.
