## PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

Primary enclosure must be kept in good repair and maintained so that they have no sharp points or edges that could injure the dogs. The following enclosures need repair:

- 1) The 1st shed enclosure housing 3 dachshunds has protruding wire on partition.
- 2) The 2nd shed enclosure housing 4 dachshunds has protruding wire on partition.
- 3) The 5th shed enclosure housing 5 dachshunds has protruding wire on partition.
- 4) The 5th freestanding enclosure housing 2 dogs has bent wire on partition and door.

The above enclosure need to be repaired.
